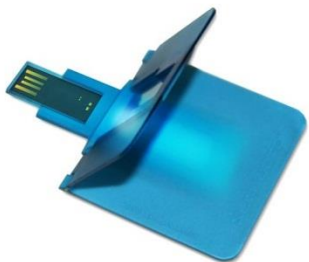
## Can Wallet-size Flash Drives Really Save Lives?
